



Enhance TV - Free Educational Resources



EnhanceTV was created by Screenrights, the audiovisual copyright society that licences Australian schools, TAFE colleges and universities to copy educational programs from television.

Teachers and librarians have been requesting a simple and quick mechanism to get licensed copies of programs that they may have missed. This is now possible through the Department's payment of the PART VA copyright licences to Screenrights with access to <http://www.enhancetv.com.au/>. A school ordering a copy of a licensed program will not have to pay an additional copyright fee for this service. They will have to pay a fee for the supply of the media on a strictly cost-recovery basis.

Free study guides can be downloaded each of the popular films and programs and a weekly email newsletter is available containing educational TV highlights and notice of new study guides and free screenings, an online TV guide and feature articles.

Each user will need to become a member of the site just once by choosing *Membership* from the top Navigation Bar. To Join:

1. Select **1. Premium Membership** in the Type of Membership and continue to enter your personal details
2. Enter the school name as the organisation
3. Enter and confirm a password of 5 or more characters.

When you are logging on as a member in future, enter your first and last name as the Username and enter the password that you have created. This will allow you to access the full range of resources at the school charge.
