

PRIMARY SCHOOL PRIORITY ENROLMENT AREAS - 2012

Schedule of priority enrolment areas (PEA) for ACT public schools (*see footnote 1*).

PEA boundaries are reviewed annually to ensure there is an acceptable balance between expected student enrolments and school capacities. Most boundaries will remain unchanged from year to year, while others may vary (for example, due to population changes).

The following table indicates the priority enrolment areas for Primary Schools for 2011.

Ainslie	Ainslie; south of Wakefield Ave (excluding Wakefield Gardens), Hassell St and Fisher St; Braddon, Canberra City, Reid
Amaroo	Amaroo, Forde, Bonner
Aranda	Aranda, Bruce, Cook
Arawang	Fisher, Waramanga, Stirling, Weston
Bonython	Bonython, north Gordon (<i>see MAP</i>), Isabella Plains
Calwell	Calwell, except the area south of Tharwa Drive (<i>see MAP</i>)
Campbell	Campbell, Duntroon, Fairbairn, Pialligo, Russell
Chapman	Chapman, Rivett, Stirling
Charles Conder	Conder; except northern part (<i>see MAP</i>), Banks, Tharwa and surrounding rural area within the ACT.
Charnwood-Dunlop	Charnwood; south of line along Bloxham St and Bettington Cct (northern part), and between Aldcorn Place and Arietta Close so as to include residents of Arietta Close, Dunlop; south and east of Kerrigan St, Flynn (part) (<i>see MAP</i>)
Chisholm	Chisholm; except south and east parts, north east Richardson (<i>see MAP</i>), students who live in Isabella Plains who have progressed through Isabella Plains Early Childhood School
Cranleigh	For students with a disability and complex support needs. Placement follows a consultative process involving parents, school and central office.
Curtin	Curtin, Lyons
Duffy	Duffy, Coombs, Holder, Mt Stromlo, rural area along Cotter Road west of Eucumbene Dr to Murrumbidgee River, Rivett, Uriarra, Weston, Wright,
Evatt	Evatt; east of Clancy Street, McKellar
Fadden	Fadden, Macarthur
Farrer	Farrer, south Isaacs (<i>see MAP</i>)
Florey	Florey, Belconnen Town Centre; north of line from Luxton St, Lathlain St, Cameron Av and Aikman Dr
Forrest	Barton, Deakin; east of line from Adelaide Ave, along Hopetoun Cct/Macgregor St/Stradbroke St/Stonehaven Cres/Strickland Cres, Forrest, Griffith; north from Flinders Way and west of La Perouse St, Parkes, Red Hill; north from Flinders Way. Fyshwick, Harman, Kingston, Oaks Estate, Symonston and part of Griffith and Narrabundah are shared with Red Hill Primary School (<i>see MAP</i>)
Fraser	Charnwood; north of line along Bloxham St and north Bettington Cct and between Aldcorn PI and Arietta CI, Flynn; north of line from Tillyard Dr between Victory / Brodie / Bird PI and Wilkinson St / Oster PI, Fraser, Dunlop; north and west of Kerrigan St (<i>see MAP</i>)
Garran	Garran, O'Malley, Phillip; north of Hindmarsh Drive
Gilmore	Gilmore, east part of Chisholm (<i>see MAP</i>), Hume
Giralang	Giralang, Crace
Gold Creek	Nicholls; west of Gungahlin pond, Ngunnawal; part (<i>see MAP</i>), Hall and surrounding rural area within the ACT, Casey
Gordon	Gordon; except for small area to the north, and including the northern part of Conder (<i>see MAP</i>)
Gowrie	Gowrie

Harrison	Harrison, Mitchell, Franklin, Gungahlin; except west of Gozzard Street, Forde
Hawker	Hawker, Scullin and Page
Hughes	Hughes, Lyons
Isabella Plains	This Early Childhood School does not have priority enrolment boundaries, however the school gives preference to students resident in the suburb of Isabella Plains.
Kaleen	Kaleen, north of Ellenborough St and including Campaspe Cct
New Kambah P-10	Kambah; south-west, north-west, south-east (<i>see MAP</i>), Greenway; west of Lake Tuggeranong
Kingsford Smith	Higgins, Holt, students who live in Scullin or Page who have progressed through Southern Cross Early Childhood School
Latham	Latham
Lyneham	Lyneham; excluding Exhibition Pk, O'Connor; north of Belconnen Way and Macarthur Ave
Lyons	This Early Childhood School does not have priority enrolment boundaries, however the school gives preference to students resident in the suburb of Lyons.
Macgregor	Macgregor
Macquarie	Macquarie, Belconnen Town Centre south of line from Luxton St, Lathlain St, Cameron Ave and Aikman Dr, Cook
Majura	Downer, Watson, Hackett
Malkara	For students with a disability and complex support needs. Placement follows a consultative process involving parents, school and central office.
Maribyrnong	Kaleen; south of Ellenborough St and including Wakool Cct, Lawson
Mawson	Mawson, Phillip; south of Hindmarsh Dr, south-west O'Malley, north Isaacs (<i>see MAP</i> , Chifley and Pearce
Miles Franklin	Evatt; west of Clancy St, south to Ginninderra Dr
Monash	Monash, Isabella Plains
Mt Rogers	Melba, Spence, Flynn (part) (<i>see MAP</i>)
Narrabundah	This Early Childhood School does not have priority enrolment boundaries, however the school gives preference to students resident in the suburb of Narrabundah.
North Ainslie	Ainslie; north of Wakefield Av (including Wakefield Gardens), Hassell St/ Fisher St, Dickson, Hackett
Ngunnawal	Ngunnawal; excluding areas accessed by Gundaroo Drive, Casey; north of Ruth Dobson Street and David Miller Crescent
O'Connor Co-Operative	This school does not have priority enrolment boundaries
Palmerston District	Palmerston, Nicholls; between Gungahlin pond and Gundaroo Drive, Ngunnawal; with access from Gundaroo Drive, Gungahlin; west of Gozzard Street, Franklin
Red Hill	Griffith; south of Flinders Way and west from La Perouse St, Narrabundah; west of Captain Cook Cr / Jerrabomberra Ave, Red Hill; south of Flinders Way. Fyshwick, Harman, Kingston, Oaks Estate, Symonston and the remainder of Griffith and Narrabundah is shared with Forrest Primary School (<i>see MAP</i>)
Richardson	Richardson; except for north-east part, southern part of Chisholm (<i>see MAP</i>), Isabella Plains
Southern Cross	This Early Childhood School does not have priority enrolment boundaries, however the school gives preference to students resident in the suburb of Scullin.
Taylor	Kambah; north-east, north-west and south-east (<i>see MAP</i>)
Teloepa Park	Students entering the bi-national Australian-French program: enrolments are ACT wide up to the agreed capacity of this program.
Theodore	Theodore, Calwell south of Tharwa Dr (<i>see MAP</i>)

Primary School	PEA Description
Torrens	Torrens, Chifley, Pearce; south of walkway linking the suburban boundary, Parkhill St, Whitham Pl, Hodgson Cr, Pendred St, Pethebridge St and Marr St, and the northern boundary of Melrose High School to Athllon Drive
Turner	Acton, O'Connor; south of Belconnen Way/Macarthur Ave, Turner. Special Enrolments are recommended by the Melrose Counselling Service.
Wanniassa	Wanniassa (see MAP), Oxley, Greenway; east of Lake Tuggeranong
Wanniassa Hills	Wanniassa (see MAP)
Weetangera	Weetangera, Page, Scullin
Yarralumla	Deakin; west of line from Adelaide Ave, along Hopetoun Circuit/Macgregor St/Stradbroke St/Stonehaven Cres/Strickland Cres, Yarralumla

FOOTNOTES

1. Priority enrolment areas (PEA) have been defined in terms of official suburban boundaries and street names, as shown on the Maps of Canberra by Suburbs. Roads may be used as boundaries for Priority Enrolment Areas. In these instances the roadway is the boundary. Proposed new development areas such as in Gungahlin, Dunlop and Macgregor have been included within the relevant priority enrolment areas to provide guidance for potential residents. PEA boundaries are reviewed annually to ensure there is an acceptable balance between expected student enrolments and school capacities. Most boundaries will remain unchanged from year to year, while others may vary.
