Schedule of priority enrolment areas for ACT public schools (*see footnote 1*)

PEA boundaries are reviewed annually to ensure there is an acceptable balance between expected student enrolments and school capacities. Most boundaries will remain unchanged from year to year, while others may vary (for example, due to population changes).

The following table indicates the priority enrolment areas (PEA) for High Schools for 2012.

FOOTNOTES

1. Priority enrolment areas (PEA) have been defined in terms of official suburban boundaries and street names, as shown on the Maps of Canberra by Suburbs. Roads may be used as boundaries for Priority Enrolment Areas. In these instances the roadway is the boundary. Proposed new development areas such as in Gungahlin, Dunlop and Macgregor have been included within the relevant priority enrolment areas to provide guidance for potential residents. PEA boundaries are reviewed annually to ensure there is an acceptable balance between expected student enrolments and school capacities. Most boundaries will remain unchanged from year to year, while others may vary (for example, due to population changes).
2. Years 9 to 10 students resident in Kambah and Greenway; west of Lake Tuggeranong have priority enrolment at either Wanniasa High or Stromlo High Schools. In 2012, Years 7 and 8 residents in this area have priority at the new Kambah P-10 School.
