

International Education Unit Fact Sheet

Enrolment Procedures for Dependants of Temporary Visa Holders

If your dependant's temporary visa category is not listed below you are required to pay international student tuition fees. Please go to the International Education Unit's website to download [2012 Application Form for Dependants of Temporary Residents](#).

If your dependant's temporary visa category is listed below you are eligible to apply for fee waiver. You will need to provide the appropriate documents to the International Education Unit by fax on +61 2 6205 9239 or by emailing ieu@act.gov.au. Please refer to the document checklist below:

Subclass 309 & 820 – Partner

- Evidence of Australian Citizenship
- Passport & Visa of primary visa holder and dependant
- Evidence of Medicare status

Subclass 406 – Government Agreement Visa & 411– Exchange

Only government to government exchanges are eligible for fee waiver. Private company arrangements are liable for full international student tuition fees.

- Copy of Passport & Visa of sponsored parent and child
- Employment contract

Subclass 419 – Visiting Academic

Only long term students will be considered for a fee waiver, if schooling is for 5 to 10 weeks please go to the International Education Unit's website to download the [2012 Short Term Application Form](#) for short term students.

- Copy of Passport & Visa of parent and child
- Letter of offer from sponsored university in the ACT

Subclass 457 – Business (Long Stay)

Please be advised that only the occupations listed in the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) [Skilled Occupation List](#) (SOL), Schedule 3 for visas granted prior to 1 July 2011 or Schedule 1 for visas granted after 1 July 2011, are eligible for a fee waiver.

- Copy of Passport & Visa of sponsored parent and child
- Email evidence from the Department of Immigration and Citizenship of ANZSCO code AND/OR occupation name as listed on the Skilled Occupation List- Schedule 3 prior to 1 July 2011 or Schedule 1 after 1 July 2011.
- Employment contract

Subclass 573 – Higher Education & 574 Postgraduate Research Sector

Only dependants of Commonwealth assisted students or dependants of students whose tuition fees are paid in full by a publicly funded Australian Higher Education Provider are eligible for a fee waiver.

- Copy of Passport & Visa of scholarship holder and child
- Letter of offer from university
- Evidence of scholarship and dates applicable

Subclass 576 - AusAID or Defence Sector

- Copy of Passport & Visa of scholarship holder and child
- Evidence of AusAID/Defence scholarship and dates applicable

Refugees, special purpose visa and humanitarian or protection visa

Please contact the International Education Unit for information on required documentation.

If your application for fee waiver is successful, the International Education Unit will notify the nominated school of your child's status as being fee exempt. You will need to contact the school to discuss their enrolment procedures and requirements.

If the application for a fee waiver is not successful, you will be liable to pay international student tuition fees. Once you forward the completed [2012 Application Form for Dependants of Temporary Residents](#) and payment of international student tuition fee has been made, the International Education Unit will notify the nominated school of your child's status as a full fee paying student.
